Overview of works

Track renewal

What we will be doing:

We are going to replace the old, worn railway track by lifting it up, removing it, laying a new stone base and relaying new track.

The equipment that will be used:

To carry out this work we will have on-track rail machines, generators, lights and small hand tools in use within the area. We expect the noise level to be moderate to high.

Trough route installation

What we will be doing:

We are going to install new troughing to house and protect new cables along the length of the railway line.

The equipment that will be used:

A road-rail vehicle will deliver the troughing. A road-rail vehicle, excavator and hand tools will be used for installation. We expect the noise level to be low to moderate.

Lineside fencing installation

What we will be doing:

We will be installing new fencing to mark and secure the railway boundary.

The equipment that will be used:

We will be using small plant and hand tools. We expect the noise level to be low.

Electrification of Overhead Lines – Notification of Energisation



As part of our ongoing programme to upgrade the Transpennine main line between York, Leeds and Manchester, the railway between Colton Junction and Church Fenton North will soon be electrified.

From 00:01 on Sunday 7 July 2024, the Overhead Line Equipment (OLE) above the tracks between these points will be live and energised. The overhead wires and supporting equipment that sits above the railway line will be carrying electricity at **25,000 volts**.
