## ***What exactly are we doing?***

We will be carrying out track renewal works. This requires us to replace the old, worn railway track by lifting it up, removing it, laying a new stone base and re-laying the new track.

## ***What equipment will we be using?***

To carry out this work we will be using on-site trains, on-track rail machines, generators, lights and small hand tools. We expect the noise level to be moderate to high.

## ***How will we manage our impact on you?***

We understand that working near your property isn't ideal and I'm sorry in advance for any disruption that this might cause. However, our staff have been briefed and will be mindful when working, making sure we've taken all the necessary steps to minimise and if possible, avoid noise disturbance.
